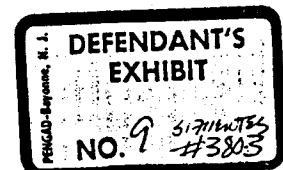

narrative:

ON TUESDAY 08/06/96 AT APPROXIMATELY 2:08 AM THE POLICE DEPT
RECEIVED A 911 CALL. DISPATCHER DENNIS TAYLOR ANSWERED THE CALL AND I
COULD HEAR A FAINT VOICE IN THE BACKGROUND COMING FROM THE 911 LINE
ORDER. THIS OFFICER COULD NOT HEAR THIS VOICE WELL SO I PICKED UP
THE OTHER LINE AND MONITORED THE CONVERSATION. THE CALLER WAS ASKING
FOR HELP AND THAT SHE HAD BEEN SHOT. THIS OFFICER THEN HUNG MY LINE UP
AND SAW THAT THE CALL WAS COMING FROM 1802 HALL AVE (JOLLY ROGER). THIS
OFFICER THEN LEFT THE POLICE DEPT WHILE DENNIS CONTINUED TO SPEAK WITH
THE VICTIM. WHILE ENROUTE TO JOLLY ROGER THIS OFFICER MADE CONTACT WITH
OFFICER HILBURN AND OFFICER PONCE BY RADIO AND INFORMED THEM THAT THERE
MAY BE POSSIBLY A GUN SHOT VICTIM AT JOLLY ROGER. UPON ARRIVING AT JOLLY
ROGER AT APPROXIMATELY 2:10 AM THIS OFFICER NOTED A BLACK MALE IN THE
PARKING LOT WAVING HIS HANDS ABOVE HIS HEAD ATTEMPTING TO GET MY
ATTENTION. THIS BLACK MALE IS KNOWN TO THIS OFFICER AS JACKIE JOHNSON
DOB 08/10/63. AS I EXITED MY VEHICLE JACKIE TOLD ME THAT THE CLERK
INSIDE THE STORE WAS BLEEDING AND HURT BADLY. THIS OFFICER THEN WENT
INSIDE JOLLY ROGER AND WAS MET BY ANOTHER BLACK MALE LATER IDENTIFIED AS
MATTHEW WOOLEY DOB 10/28/64. MATTHEW WAS VERY UPSET AND INFORMED ME THAT
THE CLERK WAS BEHIND THE COUNTER BLEEDING AND SHE NEEDED AN AMBULANCE.
THIS OFFICER THEN LOOKED OVER THE COUNTER AND SAW A WHITE FEMALE LATER
IDENTIFIED AS TRACY RUSSELL LEANING OVER A HISPANIC FEMALE ATTEMPTING TO
COMFORT HER LAYING ON THE FLOOR. THIS OFFICER THEN ADVISED DISPATCH TO
SEND EMS TO THIS LOCATION. AT THIS TIME THIS OFFICER SAW A LARGE
AMOUNT OF BLOOD IN WHICH THE VICTIM WAS LYING. THIS OFFICER ALSO NOTED
THAT THE DRAWER TO THE CASH REGISTER WAS OPEN AND SAW THAT THERE WERE NO
BILLS INSIDE. I ALSO NOTED THAT THE PHONE WAS BLOODY WITH A WHITE PAPER
JEWEL WRAPPED AROUND THE HANDSET WHICH WAS LAYING ON A COUNTER, OFF THE
HOOK. THIS OFFICER SAW THAT THERE WAS BLOOD ON THE COUNTER WHERE THE
PHONE RECEIVER WAS LOCATED. THIS OFFICER SAW A QUART OF OIL AND A
PACKAGE OF CIGARETTES LAYING ON THE FRONT COUNTER.
AT THIS TIME OFFICER HILBURN AND PONCE ARRIVED AND CAME INSIDE THE STORE.
THIS OFFICER THEN WENT BEHIND THE COUNTER WHERE THE VICTIM WAS LAYING.
THE VICTIM WAS LAYING WITH HER HEAD TO THE WEST AND FEET TO EAST. AT
THIS POINT TRACY LEFT FROM BEHIND THE COUNTER AND THIS OFFICER NOTED
THAT THERE WAS A LARGE AMOUNT OF BLOOD THAT WAS ON THE FLOOR AND ON THE
VICTIM'S FACE AND HAIR. THIS OFFICER ALSO NOTED THAT THE VICTIM WAS
HOLDING HER RIGHT SIDE. THIS OFFICER COULD NOT TELL AT THIS POINT WHERE
THE BLOOD WAS COMING FROM. I NOTED THAT BELOW AND TO THE RIGHT OF THE
LEVEL THERE WAS A ROUND BLOOD STAIN ON THE PAIR OF JEANS SHE WAS WEARING.
THIS OFFICER WHILE LOOKING FOR WHERE THE BLOOD WAS COMING FROM WAS
ASKING THE VICTIM QUESTIONS. THIS OFFICER THEN SAW APPROXIMATELY 4
BULLET HOLES IN THE VICTIM'S ABDOMEN AS I MOVED HER HAND FROM HER SIDE.
THIS OFFICER ALSO NOTED THAT THESE WOUNDS WERE NOT BLEEDING. THE VICTIM,
AT MY FIRST CONTACT, WAS LAYING ON HER RIGHT SIDE AND THEN ROLLED TO HER
LEFT AND THEN BACK TO HER RIGHT SIDE WITH HER KNEES PULLED UPWARD
TOWARDS HER CHEST. VICTIM REPEATEDLY STATED THAT SHE HURT AND NEEDED
HELP. THIS OFFICER NOTED THAT VICTIM WAS IN EXTREME PAIN BUT COHERENT.
THE VICTIM ALSO STATED THAT SHE NEEDED TO GET UP OFF THE FLOOR.
WHILE ATTEMPTING TO COMFORT VICTIM I ASKED HER WHO HAD SHOT HER AND SHE
STATED "TWO HISPANIC MALES ONE WITH LONG HAIR AND THE OTHER WITH SHORT
HAIR ABOUT 18 TO 20 YEARS OLD".
THE VICTIM STATED THAT ONE OF THE SUSPECTS WORE SHADES. THIS OFFICER
