6. Shortly after calling the Crimestopper organization, Janie Ramirez told me that the Littlefield Police Department contacted her.

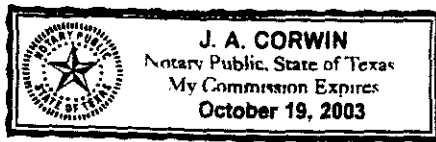
7. Janie Ramirez also told me that she heard that Crimestoppers might offer her \$2000. She stated that she declined to take the money from Crimestoppers.
