

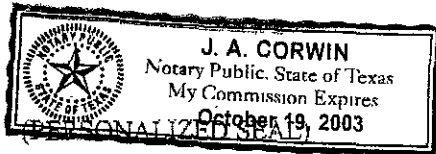
4. Janie Ramirez told me that she was unemployed, and she had no visible means of income. She also told me that she could not use the stove in her home because she could not pay the gas bill.


5. In addition, Ms. Ramirez told me that she would be spending three days in jail because she could not afford to pay a traffic ticket.
