 ON TUESDAY 08-06-96 AT APPROXIMATELY 0745 HOURS, DETECTIVE SERGEANT J. BAKER WAS CONTACTED BY TEXAS RANGER SALVADOR ABREO. ABREO REQUESTED THE ASSISTANCE OF THE IDENTIFICATION SECTION OF THIS DEPARTMENT IN THE PROCESSING OF A CAPITAL MURDER CRIME SCENE AT THE JOLLY ROGER CONVENIENCE STORE AT 1800-HALL AVENUE IN LITTLEFIELD, TEXAS.

SERGEANT BAKER AND MYSELF LEFT LUBBOCK AND ARRIVED IN LITTLEFIELD AT THE PLACE OF OCCURRENCE AT APPROXIMATELY 0845 HOURS. WE ASSISTED THE TEXAS RANGERS, LITTLEFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY CRIME LABORATORY CRIMINALISTS IN THE PROCESSING OF THE SCENE.

UPON OUR ARRIVAL (BAKER AND MYSELF) WE AWAITED THE ARRIVAL OF RANGER ABREO TO RETURN TO THE SCENE. ABREO HAD ADVISED THAT OUR PRESENCE WAS NEEDED IN PROCESSING THE SCENE FOR LATENT PRINTS. THE EXTERIOR OF THE CONVENIENCE STORE WAS PROTECTED BY CRIME SCENE BARRIER TAPE, AND D.P.S. CRIMINALIST WERE INSIDE THE STORE EXAMINING IT FOR TRACE EVIDENCE.

WE EVENTUALLY TOOK A LOOK AT THE INSIDE OF THE STORE. THERE IS A SET OF DOUBLE DOORS ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE STORE AND THEN A SINGLE DOOR ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE STORE. INSIDE OF THE STORE ALONG THE EAST WALL/WINDOWS THERE ARE SEVERAL RESTAURANT STYLE TABLE AND CHAIR BOOTHS. THE CHECK-OUT COUNTER SAT ALONG THE NORTH WALL TO THE WEST OF THE NORTH DOOR. ONE OF THE CASH REGISTERS HAD IT'S CASH DRAWER OPEN. BLOOD WAS OBSERVED ON THE FLOOR BEHIND THE COUNTER.

ON THE COUNTER BESIDE THE CASH REGISTER WAS A BOTTLE OF QUAKER STATE MOTOR OIL WHICH WAS REPORTEDLY PLACED THERE BY A CUSTOMER WHO CAME IN AFTER THE OCCURRENCE. BESIDE THE QUAKER STATE WAS A PACK OF GPC CIGARETTES (ITEM #13), TWO OTHER GPC CIGARETTE PACKAGES (ITEMS #11 AND #12) WERE FURTHER BACK ON THE COUNTER NEAR A RACK FOR THE GPC CIGARETTES.

THERE WERE A TOTAL OF EIGHT .22 CALIBER SHELL CASINGS LOCATED INSIDE OF THE STORE, AND ONE JUST OUTSIDE THE NORTH DOOR OF THE STORE (ITEMS #1 THROUGH #9). ALL OF THEIR LOCATIONS HAD BEEN DOCUMENTED AND MEASUREMENTS WERE LATER TAKEN OF THEIR LOCATION. ON THE FLOOR BEHIND THE COUNTER, A MEDALLION "MARIANA" (ITEM #10) WAS FOUND.

AS SERGEANT BAKER TOOK COLOR PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE SCENE, I PROCEEDED TO DUST FOR LATENT PRINTS. THE GAS PUMPS, THE EXTERIOR AND INTERIOR OF THE EAST DOORS AND THE NORTH DOOR WERE DUSTED WITH BLACK FINGERPRINT POWDER. AFTER I DUSTED, I PLACED FINGERPRINT TAPE OVER THE LATENTS AND SERGEANT BAKER THEN PLACED WHITE CARDS ON THE LATENTS AND MARKED THE CARDS OF THE LOCATION OF THE LATENTS. NUMEROUS LATENT PRINTS WERE FOUND AND LIFTED, AND THEY WILL BE OF THE PALM AND FINGERS. A GLASS TOP COUNTER TOP TO THE EAST OF THE OPENED REGISTER HAD ALREADY BEEN DUSTED WITH A RED LUMINESCENT POWDER (BY ONE OF THE LITTLEFIELD OFFICERS), BUT THE LATENTS NOT LIFTED. I PLACED TAPE ON THOSE LATENTS AND THEY WERE LIFTED.

ATTEMPTS TO DUST THE COUNTERTOP BESIDE THE REGISTER WITH BLACK POWDER WAS TRIED, BUT THE COUNTERTOP WAS PITTED AND THE FINGERPRINT DUST FILLED THE HOLES, NOT ADHERING TO ANY LATENTS. A SET OF FAINT SHOEPRINTS COULD BE SEEN ON THE COUNTERTOP. A SIGN OVERHEAD OF THE COUNTER WAS OBSERVED TO HAVE POSSIBLE SMUDGED/OILY PRINTS. IT IS POSSIBLE AS THE SUSPECT STOOD ON THE COUNTER, HE HELD HIMSELF UP BY GRABBING THE SIGN. THE SIGN WAS OF A PAINTED ROUGH WOOD WHICH ALSO APPEARED TO NOT BE CONDUCTIVE TO BLACK POWDER FOR DUSTING OF LATENTS.

I SUGGESTED TO RANGER ABREO TO HAVE THE COUNTERTOP CUT OUT, AND THE SIGN ABOVE REMOVED AND BOTH ITEMS TAKEN TO THE D.P.S. LABORATORY LATENT SECTION IN AUSTIN FOR PROCESSING OF LATENT PRINTS. (I WAS ADVISED THAT THIS WAS LATER DONE AFTER MY DEPARTURE.)

I COLLECTED THE NINE SHELL CASINGS, THE "MARIANA" MEDALLION, AND THE THREE PACKAGES OF CIGARETTES. I ALSO COLLECTED THE CASH REGISTER DRAWER FROM THE OPEN CASH REGISTER. ALL ITEMS WERE COLLECTED AT APPROXIMATELY 1230 HOURS. THESE ITEMS WERE COLLECTED FOR THE PROCESSING OF LATENT PRINTS AT MY OFFICE.

I DUSTED SEVERAL ITEMS IN AND AROUND THE COUNTER WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. AT THE CONCLUSION OF DUSTING FOR LATENT PRINTS, SERGEANT BAKER AND MYSELF STOOD BY AND ASSISTED WHILE THE CASH REGISTER TAPES WERE CHECKED AND THE TIMES DOCUMENTED.

WHEN BAKER AND MYSELF LEFT THE SCENE, IT WAS STILL BEING PROCESSED BY OTHER OFFICERS. ALL EVIDENCE OBTAINED AT THE SCENE WAS TAKEN BACK TO LUBBOCK AND STORED AT THE LUBBOCK POLICE DEPARTMENT IDENTIFICATION SECTION OFFICES.

THE LATENTS WERE EXAMINED AND SOME OF THE LATENTS WERE FOUND TO BE SUFFICIENT TO ENTER INTO THE AUTOMATED FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM COMPUTER. ONE OF THE LATENTS ENTERED RETURNED WITH A POSSIBLE CANDIDATE FOR A MATCH. THIS LATENT WAS LIFTED FROM THE INSIDE OF THE NORTH DOOR. THIS LATENT WAS EVENTUALLY FOUND TO BE A MATCH TO DAVID CRAIG SPEAKMAN W/M 09-06-68, WHOSE CCH SHOWED TO HAVE A RECORD IN LITTLEFIELD. THERE WERE NO OTHER HITS MADE ON THE REST OF THE LATENTS RAN IN A.F.I.S.

ON 08-08-96 (THURSDAY), I WAS NOTIFIED BY RANGER YEAGER OF POSSIBLE SUSPECTS IN LEVELLAND. I DROVE TO LEVELLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT WHERE I TALKED WITH DETECTIVE TAMMY DAVIS. DAVIS PROVIDED ME WITH FINGERPRINT CARDS FOR ARMANDO GONZALES H/M 10-11-78 AND JERRY GONZALES H/M 08-01-77. ON 08-09-96 (FRIDAY) I CHECKED THE LATENTS AGAINST THE GONZALES' WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS, NO MATCH. THE FINGERPRINT CARDS FOR THE GONZALES' WILL BE MAILED BACK TO DETECTIVE DAVIS IN LEVELLAND.

I BECAME INVOLVED IN A HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION IN LUBBOCK AND WAS UNABLE TO PROCESS THE ITEMS COLLECTED AT THE SCENE. ON 08-14-96 (WEDNESDAY) RANGER ABREO CAME TO MY OFFICE AND COLLECTED ALL OF THE ITEMS (#1 THROUGH #14).

OF THE LATENTS COLLECTED AT THE SCENE ON THE DOORS AND GAS PUMPS, LATENTS WERE FOUND THAT WERE IDENTIFIABLE, THE LATENTS WERE OF FINGERS AND PALMS.

RANGER ABREO PROVIDED ME WITH FINGER AND PALM PRINTS OF SUSPECTS JESUS RAMIREZ AND ALBERTO SIFUENTES. HE ALSO PROVIDED ME WITH ONLY THE FINGERPRINTS OF A MARY DAVILA.

ON 09-12-96, I CHECKED THE FINGERPRINTS OF ALL SUSPECTS AGAINST THE FINGERPRINT LATENTS WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS, NO MATCH. I ATTEMPTED TO CHECK THE PALM PRINTS OF THE SUSPECTS AGAINST THE LATENT PALM PRINTS, BUT THE PALM PRINTS FOR THE SUSPECTS WERE INSUFFICIENT FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES. BETTER PALM PRINTS WILL BE NEEDED ON THE MALE SUSPECTS, AND PALM PRINTS WILL BE NEEDED FOR THE FEMALE SUSPECT.

ON 10-16-96, I LEARNED THAT ALBERTO SIFUENTES (4-22-73) AND JESUS RAMIREZ ESQUEVIL (12-20-48) WERE BE HELD FOR LAMB COUNTY AT THE LUBBOCK COUNTY JAIL. I WENT TO THE JAIL WHERE I OBTAINED PALM PRINTS FROM BOTH OF THE SUSPECTS. ON 10-18-96, I CHECKED THE LATENT PALM PRINTS AGAINST ALBERTO AND JESUS WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS, NO MATCH.

THE LATENTS WILL BE IN THE I.D. FILES. THE FINGER AND PALM PRINTS OF THE SUSPECTS WILL BE FILED IN RECORDS.
