I.

My last employment was with [PARADISE CLUB] of
[LUBBOCK TEXAS].

MY NAME IS MIGUEL TIJERINA AND I AM EMPLOYED AT THE PARADISE CLUB AT 2822
CLOVIS ROAD IN LUBBOCK TEXAS. I HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED THERE FOR ABOUT A YEAR AND
A HALF. I AM THE BARTENDER/WAITER/SECURITY GUARD, JUST WHATEVER I NEED TO DO.
ON MONDAY, 08-05-96, I WENT TO WORK AT ABOUT 6:00PM. WHEN I ARRIVED AT WORK I
NOTICED ABOUT FIVE OR SIX PEOPLE IN THE CLUB. THERE WERE TWO MEXICAN MEN AND A
WOMAN THAT WERE TOGETHER. ONE OF THE MEXICAN MEN WITH THE WOMAN WAS YOUNG AND
THE OTHER ONE WAS OLDER, I THINK SOMEWHERE IN HIS FORTIES. I DO NOT THINK I
HAD SEEN THEM BEFORE. WHILE I WAS WORKING THAT EVENING, I WAS THE BARTENDER.
THE TWO MEN AND THE WOMAN THAT WERE TOGETHER WERE DRINKING AND I REMEMBER THE
WOMAN SEEM TO BE A HEAVY DRINKER. I DONT KNOW WHY BUT THE WOMAN KEPT CALLING
ME "DAVID". THEY WERE THERE FOR AWHILE AND THEN THEY LEFT, I THINK IT MIGHT
HAVE BEEN 8:30 PM, WHEN THEY LEFT. I KNOW THEY RETURNED TOGETHER SOMETIME
LATER BUT I DID NOT SEE WHAT TIME IT WAS WHEN THEY RETURNED. THEY BEGAN
DRINKING AGAIN AND THE WOMAN WAS STILL OUT DRINKING THE MEN. SOMETIME LATER
DURING THE NIGHT, WHEN THE WOMAN WAS COMING TO THE BAR TO GET ANOTHER DRINK THE
MEN WERE SIGNALING ME NOT TO SERVE HER ANYMORE. THE WOMAN WAS NOT INTOXICATED
BUT I THINK THE MEN DID NOT WANT TO BUY HER ANY MORE DRINKS BECAUSE SHE WAS
DRINKING SO MUCH. I THINK THEY WERE THERE A FEW MORE HOURS AND THEN THEY ALL
LEFT TOGETHER. I AM ALMOST SURE THAT THEY LEFT TOGETHER SOMETIME BETWEEN 10:00
PM & MIDNIGHT THAT NIGHT. I DID NOT SEE THEM AFTER THAT. ON FRIDAY, 08-16-96,

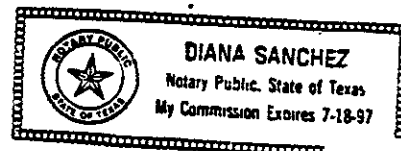
