

## RATIVE/SUPPLEMENT(s)

\*\*\*\*\*NARRATIVE BY OFFICER RICHARD WILLS\*\*\*\*\*

ON 08-12-96, WARREN YEAGER CAME TO THE MULESHOE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR INFORMATION ON A HOMICIDE.

OFFICER BENNY PARKER, OFFICER RALPH SANCHEZ, OFFICER KENNY EVANS, SGT. HECTOR SANCHEZ AND I ASSISTED IN PICKING UP ALBERTO SIFUENTES AND JESUS RAMIREZ FOR QUESTIONING. OFFICER PARKER AND I ALSO ASSISTED WITH STANDING BY WITH JESUS RAMIREZ TO SEARCH, WITH CONSENT, A TRAVEL TRAILER, WEST OF TOWN BY THE RANCH HOUSE. WARREN YEAGER AND AN ASSISTANT DID THE SEARCH. JESUS RAMIREZ'S GOLD 1983 LINCOLN WAS STORED IN THE GARAGE ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE MULESHOE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AT THE REQUEST OF THE TEXAS RANGERS TO KEEP THE CAR IN A SAFE PLACE.

OFFICER PARKER, OFFICER EVANS AND I SAT IN THE PATROL ROOM AS THE TEXAS RANGERS INTERVIEWED JESUS RAMIREZ. RANGER WARREN YEAGER TOLD US TO QUESTION JESUS, WHILE HE, (RANGER YEAGER), WAS OUT OF THE ROOM TO SEE IF WE COULD GET ANY NEW INFORMATION. THE QUESTIONS I ASKED JESUS PERTAINED TO WHEN HE HAD LEFT MULESHOE, WHERE HE HAD GONE AND TIMES. JESUS DID NOT HAVE ANY INFORMATION WHICH HAD CHANGED FROM WHAT HE TOLD THE TEXAS RANGERS.

\*\*\*NARRATIVE BY OFFICER BENNY PARKER\*\*\*

AT ABOUT 2007 HOURS, ON 08-12-96, I WAS CALLED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN REFERENCE TO THE TEXAS RANGERS WANTING TO SPEAK WITH ME.

UPON MY ARRIVAL, I SPOKE WITH WARREN YEAGER. MR. YEAGER WANTED TO KNOW WHERE I HAD GOTTEN ALL THE INFORMATION THAT CHIEF LIVINGSTON AND I SENT TO LITTLEFIELD ON THE HOMICIDE. I TOLD HIM THAT I HAD JUST LOOKED UP PEOPLE IN THE COMPUTER THAT MIGHT FIT THE DESCRIPTION. HE THEN ASKED ME IF I WOULD LOOK TO SEE IF I COULD FIND SOME PEOPLE IN OUR COMPUTER. I THEN LEFT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

ON 08-12-96, I CAME BACK TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND NOTICED THAT THE TEXAS RANGER HAD TWO HISPANIC MALES IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. RANGER YEAGER STATED THAT THEY WERE TRYING TO GET THE TWO MALES TO GIVE CONSENT TO SEARCH.

AT ABOUT 2230 HOURS, ON 08-12-96, OFFICER RALPH SANCHEZ AND I FOLLOWED THE TEXAS RANGER TO A SMALL TRAILER HOUSE LOCATED ON THE SOUTH EAST SIDE OF THE RANCH HOUSE MOTEL IN THE BACK.

UPON OUR ARRIVAL, WE WENT TO THE DOOR OF THE TRAILER. TEXAS RANGER WARREN YEAGER AND A FEMALE RANGER WENT INTO THE RESIDENCE. I THEN HEARD YEAGER STATE THAT HE FOUND A PISTOL. I THEN WENT IN TO ASSIST RANGER YEAGER AND FOUND SOME TENNIS SHOES UNDER A BED. RANGER YEAGER THEN TOOK THE SHOES AND PLACED THEM WITH HIS EVIDENCE. WE THEN LEFT THE RESIDENCE.

WHILE AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, YEAGER HAD OFFICER RALPH SANCHEZ AND I GO BACK TO THE RESIDENCE AND LOOK IN THE TRASH CAN LOCATED JUST WEST OF THE RESIDENCE ABOUT 300 FEET. I FOUND A PAPER BAG FROM AN ALLSUP'S STORE IN THE TRASH CAN AND A TEXAS TAG #BHCR61.

WE THEN LEFT AND RETURNED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

UPON OUR ARRIVAL AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, WE WERE IN THE PATROLMAN'S OFFICE WITH YEAGER WHILE HE WAS INTERVIEWING JESUS RAMIREZ. DURING THE INTERVIEW, I DON'T REMEMBER EVERYTHING THAT WAS SAID BUT THE ONE THING THAT STUCK IN MY MIND WAS THAT, WHILE YEAGER WAS TALKING WITH JESUS RAMIREZ, JESUS STATED TO YEAGER THAT HE DID NOT KNOW WHY ANYONE WOULD KILL SOMEONE FOR THREE HUNDRED OR FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS, WHEN HE MAKES FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS A WEEK. DURING THE INTERVIEW, JESUS RAMIREZ WAS VERY NERVOUS ABOUT SOMETHING. WHEN YEAGER LEFT THE ROOM HE STATED THAT MAYBE WE, MEANING OFFICER EVANS, CONSTABLE PIERCE AND ME, MIGHT GET SOMETHING OUT OF HIM.

AS I SPOKE WITH JESUS RAMIREZ, HE STATED THAT THEY STOPPED IN SUDAN AND LEFT A FEMALE THERE, THEN CAME HOME. HE STATED THAT THEY STOPPED AT TOWN AND COUNTRY AT THE CROSSROADS HERE IN MULESHOE. THEN LATER HE STATED THAT HE HAD STOPPED AT THE OTHER TOWN AND COUNTRY, LOCATED IN THE 1900 BLOCK OF WEST AMERICAN BLVD. RANGER YEAGER AND RANGER ABREO THEN CAME BACK INTO THE INTERVIEW ROOM AND SPOKE WITH JESUS SOME MORE.
