MISDEMEANOR CHARGE: ISSUANCE OF A BAD CHECK


IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

AGAINST THE PEACE AND DIGNITY OF THE STATE.

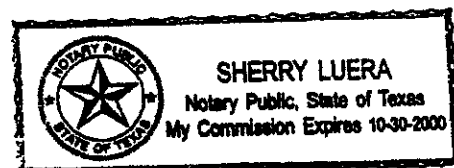

ORDER FOR DISPOSITION OF FINE AND COSTS

Entering into this agreement with the Court will result in an adjudication of guilt on the charges against you. You may enter a plea of nolo contendere (no contest) or a plea of guilty. On a plea of nolo contendere you are not contesting the charges. A finding of guilt will be entered by the Court and you may dispose of the charges as indicated below. On a plea of guilty you are admitting guilt. The fine and court costs are the same as a plea of nolo contendere. A guilty plea may adversely affect you in the event that Civil litigation is brought against you.

The defendant may discharge the fine(s) and court costs assessed against him/her in the following manner:

1. Payment in full
2. Payment of timely installments as ordered by the Court
3. Performance of community service as specified by the Court
4. Work release
5. Payment of reduced fine in the amount of _____ plus court costs (this is for those who are indigent)

IT IS THE DEFENDANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY THE COURT IF HE/SHE IS UNABLE TO MAKE PAYMENT ON THE DUE DATE OR TO CONTINUE MAKING PAYMENTS UNDER THE TERMS OF THIS ORDER. Defendant's failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this order may result in a CAPIAS PRO FINE warrant being issued for his/her arrest. Such a warrant may result in confinement in jail until the fine(s) and court costs assessed have been fully discharge as provided by law. This means that you will have to pay the balance in full at the time of arrest or lay it out in jail.
